+ **Membership Report:** 273 members, 235 paid. Last year at the same time we had 286 w/ 242 paid. Don mentioned about new members seeking instruction.

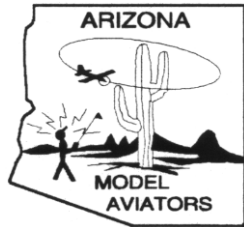


**Please take note:**



# Items For Field Maintenance Consideration

1. Get rid of plastic mats at the starting stations
2. Paint the bleachers as necessary. Mainly the frames and the floor boards
3. Get rid of all unnecessary tubing and metal around the sight & re-stack what we keep
4. Drag the field around the runway, the pits and the parking lot for weeds
5. Upgrade the electrical system for the events (already approved by the board)
6. Add more starting tables
7. Repair the lights on the ceiling
8. Repair the entrance to the field where the concrete meets the asphalt by Meridian Rd.
9. Replace any bad foam at the starting stations
10. Replace the noodles at the end of the runway
11. Clean up and re-grade the berms in the parking lot
12. Finish painting the parking bollards where needed
13. Clean, repair and remove chairs as necessary
14. Repair or replace fencing around the flight stations
15. Clean out bunkers
16. Seal the block walls where the generator stays during events to prevent further deterioration.
17. Put another row of card slots on the impound board for the 2.4 Ghz. radios
