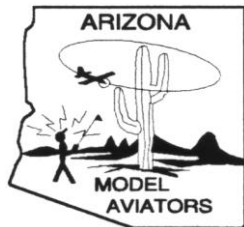

February 2, 2010 Meeting Minutes

+ **Officers Present:** John Mangino, Art Ashenden, Gary Bailey, Paul Goldsmith.

**Meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.**

+ **Treasurers report:** Gary discussed the different funds and the disbursements made from them. He explained a comparison made to last years funds at this time of the year. The parks dept. was sent the money owed them from parking at the events held.

+ **Membership Report:** 253 members have renewed their memberships to date with 217 of them being paid memberships. Last year there were 265. We are behind last year. There are 80 delinquent members. We have 29 new members with 21 of them being paid. Last year there were 39, but 16 did not renew. The difference in the numbers between paid and renewed are families and Life members.

+ **Safety Report:**. Takeoffs and landings have to be called out loudly. No serious problems.

+ **Public Relations :** Speed world charged \$10 for their parking fee at their last Jet rally. A plaque will be given to the Independent for their help in advertising our events. They are the only newspaper to do so.

The club business cards were discussed. The club charter should be available by the end of February.

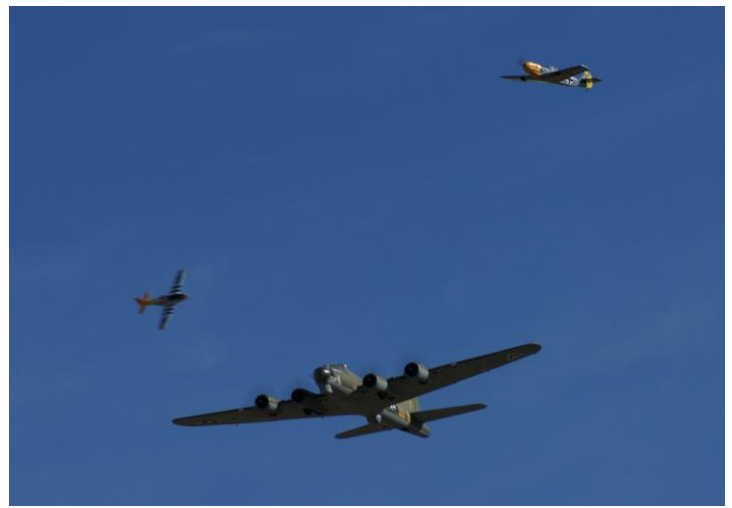
The handicapped porta potty was discussed.


