+ Club Meeting Minutes October 2, 2010

This month's meeting was held at the field.

Officers Present: John Mangino, Art Ashenden, Gary Bailey, Paul Goldsmith.

+ John called the meeting to order at 9:30 AM.. There were no guests.

+ The minutes from the September meeting were read and accepted.

+ **Treasurers Report:** Gary Bailey discussed the amounts of money in the different accounts and the CD's we have. The report was accepted by the membership.

+ **Membership:** Our new membership chairman, Jerry Morescki said we have 282 members as of now. This is down a bit from last year. Membership applications are available at the field and will be sent out in the newsletter for renewing members. It will also be available on the web site.

+ **Camac:** Art Ashenden read off the schedule of .25 size races which will be posted at the field and in the newsletter. There was one race rescheduled due to a conflict with the 1/8th Airforce. The race will be October 31st. The Auction will be 11/6/2010. The Jet Rally is a three day event starting 11/19/2010 and Wings over Arizona, an IMAA giant scale event will be a two day event on 12/4 & 12/5. For other events, see the Camac schedule at the back of the newsletter.

+ **Safety:** Some pilots are taking liberties with the dead line and this must stop. It is there for reason. Keep your planes out over the berm. Guys are not calling out takeoffs and landings so that other flyers can hear them. You have to call out toward the other flyers, not away from them. Spotters are highly recommended. Keep an ear out for dead sticks and emergencies. Do not arm electrics until you are out on the starting tables. A throttle could get bumped and cause an accident. It has happened here at the field. Don't go out after a plane by yourself, the snakes are still out. If you see someone in trouble on the flight line, go out and help them or tell someone who could help them about the issue.

+ **Instruction:** Nothing new.

+ **Public Relations:** Jim Deming was at the meeting to discuss the efforts being made to publicize the upcoming events. You can see the press release for the jet rally in

the back of the newsletter. Saturday 10/23 there will be some people out here shooting rockets up in the parking lot. Be aware.

+ **Old Business:** We are going to try to fly off 2 flight stations today to see how it works out. This is just a test to see if it will work. The main reason for this is safety as guys can't hear when take offs and landings are called out and dead sticks go unheard. If it works out well we will reconfigure the flight stations permanently.

+ **Auction :** Art spoke briefly about the auction, and his need for volunteers.

+ **Jet Rally:** Art spoke about the jet rally and the need for volunteers. He also talked about the shirts for the event. He needs a minimum number of orders to facilitate the ordering of the shirts. He would like to see them all pre-ordered so that he doesn't have to guess about sizes. They are \$25 up to XXX. Anything larger will have to be pre-ordered. See the flyer at the back of the newsletter for more details about the event. If you don't help, you won't be allowed in the pits.

+ **Wings Over Arizona:** This is an IMAA event and is for giant scale aircraft only. You must be a member of the IMAA. The membership fee is only \$25 a year and you get a magazine quarterly. Help is also needed for this event and there will be a pizza party for the entrants and the help Saturday night. Come out and take a look at us.

+ **Nominations:** We need 4 officers and two board members this year. Volunteer and help run the club. If you are not happy about something this is one way to get it changed. See Jim Jordan or Bob Franklin if you are interested in making a difference.

+**New Business:** The field will be closed the week of October 11th to the 18 for re-surfacing. Exact dates will be e-mailed out and posted at the field.

Meeting adjourned at about 10:00 AM.

The raffle was held . There was a Cub, a ratchet screwdriver set, an airplane stand, a Saito 56 Golden knight, some mixing cups and a centering drill, a pin vise and a small cordless electric drill.

We then had a cookout for all present. Everyone had a good time.

+ **Board meeting Minutes October 19, 2010**

Members present: John Mangino, Art Ashenden, Gary Bailey, Paul Goldsmith, Gary Porter, Don Manchester, Bob Franklin, Dave Balch, Jerry Morescki.

+ **The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.**

+ **Membership:** Jerry said we have 6 or 7 renewals and 1 or 2 new members. Clips and laminations for the membership cards will be available at the meeting after the stickers are received. The cost for both will be \$2.

+ **Contest Committee:** See the attached Camac schedule at the back of the newsletter for a list of events.

+ **Safety:** Please use the taxi way for taxiing back to the flight station. One gentleman taxied back behind the pilots at the flight station because he couldn't stop his engine. It could have been a disaster if something else had gone wrong and the plane had glitched. He admitted he had made a mistake and the issue is closed. There are still people arming electrics on the work table. This is not to be done until you are at the flight station. From now on anyone caught doing this will have a complaint filed against them. One pilot got his fingers chewed up the other day because of this. Again: **call out your flight intentions loudly and in both directions. You need to be heard.**

+ **Old Business:** Life memberships were discussed briefly. They will be reviewed by the by-laws committee. Please send e-mail address changes and mail address changes to Jerry Morescki. If you don't send in the changes you won't receive club updates on events and happenings. We are not going to chase after you. You are suppose to be adults. I get the same e-mails back for errors every month. From now on they get deleted. Anyone interested in running for office see the article on page 4 for positions that are open. We are going to put a blacktop walkway between the S. W. corner of the Ramada and the east bunker pad, with a flare at the bunker pad to allow carts and other heavy items to be moved back and forth without dragging up all the stone between them. The additional cost to the field job will be \$400.00. This was approved unanimously by the board. The board also approved buying two new windsocks with replaceable socks at a cost of \$164.50. Replacement socks for this unit are only about \$39+ shipping vs. \$55+ ship for the windsocks we have now. Now we have to buy a whole unit. **Thanks to Elgin Edwards for finding a source for these windsocks.** Tractor rental to clean up the field for the upcoming events will be discussed after the next rain storm. The parking lot will have to dry out to clean it up. The snakes are out sunning themselves to get warm, so beware. We have seen scorpions at the field lately so watch when you pick something up.

Please don't forget to renew your AMA and Club memberships. They are due soon.

+ New Business: Painting our club website on the north side of the runway was discussed. We would do this ourselves. We have to find out what kind of paint to use as a regular paint makes the runway crack and we have a lot invested in this new surface and don't want to screw it up.

+Treasurer's Report: Gary discussed what was left of our treasury and the income expected from 2011 dues. We should be back in good shape shortly.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.

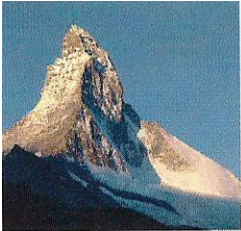
