+ Club Meeting Minutes February 1, 2011

Officers Present: Art Ashenden, Joe Miele, Gary Bailey, Paul Goldsmith.

+ The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM.

+ Art asked if there were any guests: There were some new members from the Gilbert Quiet Flyers present. Milt Taylor & Kathy along with Earl Cohen.

+ **Treasure's Report:** Gary gave an accounting of the incomes and outlays for the month. He went over what

was taken in by the Electric Festival and what the expenses were.

+ The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted. I thank Dave Balch for taking the minutes for me.

+ **Membership:** Jerry went over the totals for the month of January. As of February 1st, the membership list has been purged of all non-paying members. We have 254 paid members. Three members past away within the last years time and we picked up 26 new members. Thirteen were signed up at the Electric festival.

+ **Camac:** Joe gave his report. The next big event at the field will be Gunsmoke held by the 1/8th A.F March 4,5,6 2011. Austin Goodwin is the contest director. Joe also said he would like to meet with the electric flyers in the club.

+ **Safety:** John Mangino gave his report. He spoke of the fact that people were arming their electrics before they got to the starting tables and it cost one flyer a nice electric ducted fan jet. It started and ran into a fence post, modifying the airplane considerably, and not for the better. He requested that the pilots start landing on the runway and getting to the taxi way as soon as possible to clear the runway for others to land. John mentioned that we should walk down the sides of the field to retrieve a plane and not take the sort route across the runway on a diagonal. This causes delays for other pilots landing and taking off. He also mentioned spotters and flying the pattern.

+ **Instruction:** Jim Compton got up and spoke about the fact that students will have to have buddy box compatible radios. Art asked if The Gilbert Quiet Flyers had any instructors.

+ **Public Relations:** Steve Ross is now working with Jim Demming to help publicize the events.

+ **Old Business:** The Banquet & the New years day fun fly turned out really well thanks to Terry and her entourage. Terry talked about food at the fun flies coming up.

+ **Show & Tell:** George Kolasa gave a very informative demonstration about working with fiberglass and

detailing an airplane. He gave a lot of good tips on how to do some of the tedious work involved with a scale airplane. His FW 190 was absolutely gorgeous with all the rivets and panel lines.

+ **Williams Gateway Show:** Dave Howells talked about the upcoming show/display at Williams gateway Airport. This will occur on March 12, 2011. We will try to set up on the 11th after 11:00 AM. The show will run from 9:00 to 2:00. PM. Setup must be finished by 8:00AM.

+ **Electric Festival:** Aaron spoke about this past weekends Electric Festival. There were 233 pilots registered and about 1004 cars parked in the lot. He went over the financials of the vent and said everyone had a good time. There was excellent coverage for the event in the Arizona Republic.

+ **Falcon Field Show:** Art spoke about the upcoming show at Falcon Field. This will occur on April 2, 2011. The times will be 9:00AM until 3:00 PM. Last year we had 18 tables.

+ **By-Laws Committee:** Art spoke about the need to update the club by-laws. The first set will be mailed out to the members shortly. Bob Franklin read the 2 sections that needed to be mailed out first. By doing it this way we will be able to e-mail the rest of the changes to those members with e-mail and postal mail to those that don't. Articles 7 & 8 were read to those present. Bob also explained the ballots to those present. The committee consists of Bob Franklin, Don Manchester, Gary Bailey & Joe Miele.



Airport Operations and the FBO will stage static ramp aircraft, fire, and police displays. Phone 480-988-7700.

Directions: (see attached street map) Building #5755 is the hangar located North of the General Aviation Center (FBO). Participants can enter the hangar parking lot to unload for the exhibit hall and access the static display area. The Airport will be open during this event so you must remain in event designated areas.

Parking: After drop off please park in designated public parking.

Set up times: Friday, March 11, after 10:00 am participants may set up booths and ramp static displays. Please contact Patrick Oakley and the FBO 480-988-7700 on your arrival times. Exhibitors will be assigned locations and **provided with tables and chairs from the Airport (exhibit hall only)**. The exhibitor hall is protected from the weather and is in a secured area. The ramp static and exhibit hall are located in a secured area and displays can be left overnight. It is preferred that **Aircraft Static** arrive on Friday the 11th after 12:00. Please contact FBO 480-988-7700 to make arrangements for aircraft parking. Flight crews that will be RON please contact Gateway Aviation Service 480-988-7700 for FBO services and hotel/rental cars.

Please make sure all materials and support equipment are secured from becoming debris (FOD) on the ramp. All participants need to be set up and ready by 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning for the event. Patrick Oakley will be on site Saturday morning at 6:00 a.m. (480-406-7464). Please contact Mr. Oakley for your set up time prior to the event.
