### + Club Meeting Minutes June 7, 2011

Officers Present: Art Ashenden, Joe Miele, & Paul Goldsmith.

+ The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM.

+ Art asked if there were any guests present. Lawrence Tougas, Rich Hansen and David Luthor introduced themselves. As you probably know, Lawrence Tougas is our AMA District 10 VP. And Rich Hansen is the AMA liason with the FAA.

+ The minutes from the May meeting were read and accepted.

+ **Treasurer's Report:** Gary Bailey was not present, so a report could not be given.

+ **Membership:** Jerry Morescki then reported that the current membership stands at 304 members compared with 273 members last year at the same time.

+ **Camac:** Joe Miele then read out the list of upcoming events which included at the back of the newsletter.

+ **Safety:** John gave his report with the following items being the high points:

1. Line up behind the fence to get in line to fly.
2. Spotters can have multiple uses. Settle the talking issues before taking off. Spotter can be your caller. Don't argue about spotters.
3. The 2.4 Ghz. Pin board is to be used at all times Please return the pins when you are done flying or working on your plane..
4. Take bags out to a crash and pick up all debris.
5. Watch for the horses and bikers at the area by the fence. They must be a wide berth. Do not fly too low over their heads.
6. Ask about keys before leaving the field. Make sure someone left can lock the gate.

+ **Public Relations:** We have 3 library dates for displays. More to come on this.

+ **Please clean off the flight tables.** Don't leave your fuel residue or loose electrons for someone else to clean up.

+ **By-Laws Committee:** Section # 9 to 11 passed. The by-laws will be posted on the web site.

+ **Old Business:** Art discussed the proper use for the alternate runway. This is to be used if your airplane cannot fly the normal racetrack pattern with the larger planes or you want to do 3D maneuvers in front of yourself.

+ Rich Hansen spoke at length about our interaction with the FAA. He spoke about the reasons that the FAA is trying to get involved with model aircraft and what the AMA is doing to represent our interests. He did mention in a positive note our spotter program.

+ If anyone has a problem with the program get in touch with a club officer for details before going off the deep end about it.

+ Lawrence Tougas, our district VP spoke about his background in model aviation and the workings of the AMA executive council and the district website. He presented the club with a check for the runway grant along with a certificate. We received the largest check in the district. It will help offset some of the cost to top the runway.

+ Our guest Luthor spoke about his unique aircraft.


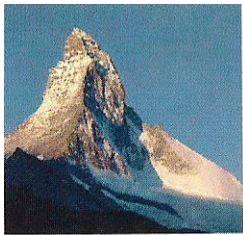


