+ Club Meeting Minutes May 3, 2011

Officers Present: Art Ashenden, Joe Miele, Gary Bailey & Paul Goldsmith.

+ The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

+ Art asked if there were any guests present and Stan Martin, a visitor from Austin Texas introduced himself. Jack Makepeace also introduced himself as a guest.

+ The minutes from the April meeting were read and accepted.

+ **Treasurer's Report:** Gary Bailey discussed the different accounts and the funds in each of them. He also talked about the disbursements made last month.

+ **Membership:** Jerry Morescki then reported that the current membership stands at 297 members compared with 268 members last year at the same time. He also stated that we had some new family members.

+ **Camac:** Joe Miele then read out the list of upcoming events which included at the back of the newsletter. The .25 size championship race is coming up this month May 15th.

+ **Instruction:** . No problems

+ **Safety:** John gave his report with the following items being the high points:

1. Watch the deadline and do not cross it. It out to infinity.
2. Line up behind the fence to get in line to fly.
3. Don't arm your plane before getting to the flight station table.
4. Use the correct taxi way coming back into the pits.
5. Spotters can have multiple uses. Settle the talking issues before taking off. Spotter can be your caller.
6. The 2.4 Ghz. Pin board is to be used at all times Please return the pins when you are done flying or working on your plane..
7. Take bags out to a crash and pick up all debris.
8. Watch for the horses and bikers at the area by the fence. They must be a wide berth. Do not fly too low over their heads.

+ **Public Relations:** OK

+ **Please clean off the flight tables. Don't leave your fuel residue or loose electrons for someone else to clean up.**

+ **Old Business:** Williams Gateway was a success. The fun fly/swap meet made \$135.00. Falcon Field was also a success. Art thanked the winter visitors. There will be an electric only fly in April 9th.

+ **By-Laws Committee:** Section # 3 to 6 passed. Don Manchester spoke about the committee. Sections # 9 to 11 are next and were discussed. The by-laws will be posted on the web site. Art went over the AMA guidelines for spotters. There will be a full size aircraft showing altitudes of 500' & 1000' this weekend.

Board Meeting May 17 , 2011

Officers present: Art Ashenden, Joe Miele, Paul Goldsmith, Gary Bailey, Gary Porter, Jerry Morescki, John Mangino, Don Manchester, Joe Bailey, Dave Balch. Bob Franklin was in attendance for the by-laws committee.

+ **The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.**

+ **Treasurer's Report:** Gary Bailey was a little late but gave his report. The different funds and money distributions were discussed.

+ **Membership:** Jerry said that there were 300 members total. We gained 2 new members since the last meeting.

+ **Contest committee:** Joe said the schedule shows a fun fly on 6/5/11.

+ **Instruction:** No report given at this time

+ **Safety:** Some members have been taxiing into the pits from the runway on the wrong side of the pilot's station. We are suppose to taxi back on the west side of the station you fly from.

+ **By-Laws Committee:** The revised by-laws will be on the web site. Bob Franklin and his committee members presented the standing rules for the lub. These were read and discussed at length. They were seconded and approved by the board members present.

+ **Art's Agenda:** Art had a list of items to go over with the board.

The Cactus Classic was discussed at length. It was given preliminary approval pending a date revision due to the possibility of Gunsmoke being held at the field again this year. More to come on this.

Joe Miele made up a list of events held at the field with the purpose of avoiding taking up too many weekends with events and denying the members use of the field. This will be monitored throughout the year.

Art has been in touch with the Mesa library. They would like us to do a display and talk at 3 different libraries in Sept. / Oct.

+**Field:** There was a list of work items for the field discussed. Having ground up asphalt applied to the incoming road was discussed but dismissed as too costly. The lights will be repaired as a minimal project due to the limited use they get. Additional outlets were discussed, but rejected for the same reason. Material costs have risen about 60% for the wire and other materials needed to do the work. There is also a problem of overloading the existing panel that is in place. To replace the panel would be an exorbitant cost for the one time a year it is used. Anyone having projects they deem necessary should notify the board and not take it upon themselves to just arbitrarily start taking things apart to examine.

There was a discussion regarding the use of the auxiliary runway. **Foamies do not have to use this runway.** The small runway is to be used for any aircraft that **cannot** fly the normal pattern of flight with the other aircraft. It is to be used when a pilot wants to fly a smaller aircraft right in front of himself as in 3D flying. It is to be used for helicopters that want to hover in front of themselves. Any aircraft that can fly the normal pattern used on the main field can and should use the main runway. Hopefully this will clear up any questions about this issue.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30


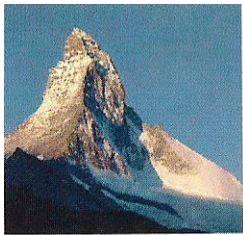


