+ **PR.** Steve Ross has started publicizing the Jet Rally. There are 9 vendors so far. Media outlets have been contacted and responses are being waited for.

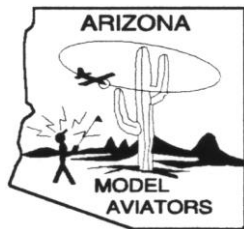
+ **Wings Over Arizona:** Paul spoke about Wings Over Arizona. Again, see the website or the flyer at the back of the newsletter.

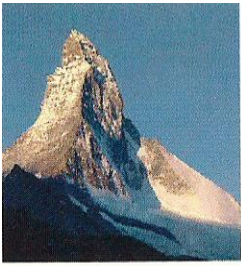
